Rotterdam Education Model

To translate the practical, hands-on mentality associated with the city of Rotterdam and the talent development of our students, into education, Rotterdam University of Applied Sciences, has developed a tightly implemented education model. Characteristic of the Rotterdam Education Model (REM) are three learning tracks: knowledge-driven,practice-driven and student-driven education. In the Master in Logistics Management programme the three learning tracks are put into practice as follows.

Knowledge-Driven - Following theoretical courses in Logistics and Supply Chain Management.

Practice-Driven - Completing an International project with your peers to solve a real-world problem for an international company. Designing and executing your graduation thesis at a company.

Student-Driven - Devising and implementing a management development plan with the support of your development coach.

Programme Structure

Our programme consists of four study blocks. During the first three blocks you will have eight weeks of course-work and one week of exams. You will take a combination of logistics management subjects and supporting subjects. You will also follow a management development programme. In block one you will also choose two electives based on your personal learning objectives. In block four you will write your final thesis.

Financial Management - Fundamental financial knowledge necessary for all managers.

Economics for Managers - Economic factors important for international managers.

Marketing/Sales & Supply Chain Management - The link between the commercial side of the organisation and the supply chain activities.

Strategic Sourcing – Building and executing a Strategic Sourcing plan.

Manufacturing Planning & Control – Making a Manufacturing Strategy & plan.

Transportation & Distribution – Designing a Distribution & Transportation network.

Current Trends in Supply Chain Management - Green Logistics, Reverse Logistics, Crisis Management.


Integrated Business Planning - Balancing the demands of the market with available capacity to meet the firm's strategic goals and objectives.

Leading & Managing Supply Chains – Making Strategic Supply Chain decisions. This course brings together all of the knowledge and skills gained during the entire programme.

International Experience

As a student in the Logistics Management programme your learning is not just limited to the classroom. Our programme offers you the unique opportunity to immediately apply the theory you learn to real-world problems. During your study you work on an International Project where you will work as part of an international student group to solve a real problem for a company. At the end of your study you will also execute your final graduation assignment for a company, using the theories and skills you have learned to solve a complex problem in the field of Finance and Accounting.

Lecturers

Our lecturers are a reflection of the international classroom. You will be taught by a multinational mix of experts in the field of Logistics and Supply Chain Management. Our lecturers have years of professional experience in multinational organisations and hold a Masters or Doctoral degree. This combination of academic knowledge and practical experience provides you with the benefit of seeing how theory is applied in practice.

Pre-Master

Rotterdam Business School offers two Pre-Master courses for students who do not yet meet all the entry requirements for the Master programmes. These courses are designed to ensure that students will be able to participate successfully in the Master programmes. If you have a Bachelor degree in business, but do not yet meet the IELTS/TOEFL or GMAT entry requirements, or if you feel you need some extra preparation for a Master programme, you may take the six-month preparation course. If you have a Bachelor degree in a non-Business field, you may take the 12-month preparation course. Successful completion of a Pre-Master course will lead to:

- A certificate for the Pre-Master course
- An exemption from the IELTS 6.5/TOEFL iBT 90 requirements
- A deduction of € 1,250* on the Non-EU tuition fees of a Master programme at Rotterdam Business School.

Application

Tuition Fees

You pay tuition fees each year. They are determined each year. The tuition fees for 2014-2015 can be found online from April 2014 at *rotterdambusinessschool.nl*

Visa and Residence Permit

Non-EU students must have a valid residence permit while studying in The Netherlands. After having received the payment of your invoice and all the required documents, Rotterdam Business School will apply for an MVV (entry visa and VVR (residence permit) at the IND (Dutch immigration and naturalisation service) on your behalf.

Housing

Rotterdam Business School can provide accommodation for the first semester students who are accepted into the programme. The rooms are rented per term and $cost \in 350^\circ$ per month (*subject to change), including all utility fees.

Living Expenses

To cover your living expenses such as housing, food, insurances and transportation you should expect to need approximately between $\in 800 - \in 1,000$ a month. Depending on your study programme you can expect to pay between $\in 300 - \in 750$ per year for books, readers and other study materials.
