

Online Entrance Exam - Bachelor's Degree Programmes 2022

HAMK invites applicants to one online exam, regardless of how many degree programmes they have applied for. The exam will be constructed from sections according to their application. The applicant will complete all the required sections for all the degree programmes they have applied for.

The applicant must pass all parts of the examination to be selected for admission. If the applicant fails to reach the minimum points in any of the examination sections or in the total score, the applicant's entrance exam will be rejected.

Registering to the online exam:

HAMK will invite all the eligibility applicants to the next possible online exam. The applicant receives an invitation to email approximately 1 - 1,5 week before the exam. We also send a text message to the phone number which has been given to us in the application. **Applicants must register themselves to the upcoming exam by the given deadline!** Only then, they can enter the exam room on the exam date.

Please note:

If an applicant meets any problems during the online exam, they should contact entranceexam@hamk.fi immediately! All the questions from the applicant concerning the exam should be sent there.

Content of the Exams:

- o Engineering programmes:
 - Basic Mathematics (max 45 min) (passing grade 50% of the total)
 - Mathematical Problem Solving (max 60 min) (passing grade 50% of the total)
 - English (max 60 min) (passing grade 60% of the total)
- o Computer Applications:
 - Basic Mathematics (max 45 min) (passing grade 50% of the total)
 - Mathematical Problem Solving (max 60 min) (passing grade 50% of the total)
 - English (max 60 min) (passing grade 60% of the total)

- o International Business:
 - Basic Mathematics (max 45 min) (passing grade 50% of the total)
 - English (max 60 min) (passing grade 60% of the total)

- o Smart Organic Farming:
 - Basic Mathematics (max 45 min) (passing grade 50% of the total)
 - English (max 60 min) (passing grade 60% of the total)

- o Smart and Sustainable Design
 - Creative task (instructions given 2 days before the exam)
 - Motivational letter (instructions given 2 days before the exam)
 - passing grade 50% of the total in assignment and PASS/FAIL in letter
 - English (max 60 min) (passing grade 60% of the total)

English Language Test in the online exam

The online exam includes a written English language test. If an applicant has a valid IELTS or TOEFL iBT scores*, or they have completed their degree in English in certain counties**, they don't need to perform HAMK's English language test in the online exam.

* Applicants will be accepted directly based on the passed written part of the entrance examination without an English language test if they have achieved at least a total score of 6.5 in the IELTS language test or TOEFL iBT total score of 79. The applicant must download a copy of the language certificate to the application together with other documents by the end of the application period.

**Applicants will be accepted directly based on the passed written part of the entrance examination without an English language test if they have upper secondary level school education, Bachelor's or Master's degree in English completed in Great Britain, Ireland, the United States, Canada, Australia or New Zealand. The applicant must download a copy of the degree certificate to the admission website.

Please notice: Applicants don't need to take the IELTS or TOEFL iBT test to be able to apply to HAMK! This is only an opportunity for those applicants, who have suitable test results so they don't need to perform HAMK's English test anymore.

Interviews:

HAMK has renounced the online interviews, so the online exam will conduct only the written exam.
