The International Honours Degree in Teaching authorises you to teach in the Danish primary and lower secondary schools, special education schools, as well as a number of international schools around the world. You can also further your studies and specialise by taking a master's degree.

During your studies, you will have numerous possibilities for international experiences. UC Absalon encourages students to go abroad, either through exchange programmes or traineeships, where you will be able to build your international portfolio and network.

The Honours Degree in Teaching programme cooperates with a large international network. The program's international coordinator is always ready to provide information and assistance to help you plan your potential stay abroad.

## **Admission Requirements**

The admission requirements for international students include one of the following certificates:

- A Danish upper secondary school leaving certificate (STX, HF, HHX, HTX, EUX, GIF)
- The Danish/French Baccalauréat (DFB)
- The European Baccalaureate (EB)
- The International Baccalaureate (IB)
- The Option Internationale du Baccalauréat (OIB)

Another foreign qualifying examination certificate that can be equated with a Danish upper secondary school leaving certificate.

Furthermore all applicants must have completed the following:

■ English: Corresponding to Danish A-level

A grade average of 7.0 (equivalent to ECTS grade C) If your grade average is below 7.0 or have a foreign or international degree, you must apply by 15 March and attend an interview (face-to-face or Zoom)

### **Tuition Fee**

If you are a citizen of an EU/EEA country, you do not have to pay a tuition fee for full degree studies.

Applicants who are non EU/EEA citizens must pay a tuition fee of DKK 33.759 (approx. EUR 4.501) per semester.



### Student Life and Clubs

There are numerous clubs and social arrangements that you as an international student at Absalon can be a part of. Some examples of the clubs you can be a part of on campus include: the cooking club, role playing & board games, book club, sports club, the theatre group, band, and many more. All of these clubs are organised by students and take place on campus

A student-led campus café & bar is also open every Friday and is the home of the many parties and events occurring throughout the year.

If making your mark on campus is what you desire, then joining the student council or the study-social environmental committee (SMU) is greatly encouraged. There you will have the opportunity to plan, structure and influence the student life with a dedicated team of fellow students.
