

Important advice for your accommodation search:

- Cphbusiness advise you to budget with a rent from € 400-850 per month depending on location and standard. A deposit is required by most landlords before moving in and is often one month's rent for a room and three months' rent for a flat. The deposit is refundable, given that you leave the room/apartment in the same state as you received it.
- You should never send money via Western Union or other private money transfer institutions but only use authorised banks and ask the landlord to send identification details – e.g. a copy of a passport.
- Watch out for landlords/owners who are out of the country, travelling or cannot meet you personally - it is usually scam.
- Do NOT pay cash.
- Do NOT send money via Western Union or similar.
- If possible, check out the room or apartment in person. If you cannot go yourself, ask a fellow student for help in the Facebook group Cphbusiness International Accommodation and Practical Help. You must as a minimum get someone to check that the apartment actually exists.
- You should always sign a contract with your landlord. Study the contract carefully and be sure to check deadlines for how to give notice.
- We strongly recommend you to take photos of the condition of the room you move into in order to prove the condition of the room when moving out.
