The course focuses on the future of the equine sector, with an emphasis on international aspects, horse welfare, and sustainability, along with strong connections to the industry.

What you will learn

During this equine programme, you will take business courses as well as courses focused on horses. Each term, you will cover two modules: one on business administration (with subjects such as marketing, sales, finance, and event management), and one on horses (with subjects such as nutrition, health, physiology, and genetics). You will start with a broad foundation of information, and then specialise through a minor, internship, and graduation project.
